REPORT ON USE OF PATH-AWAY CROP PROTECTANT

On 21st July ,2016 a Company's product labelled as path-away anti pathogen killer growth enhancer was given to the State IFAD-VCDP Office by the Company's representative for trial. As the name implies, the product is to regulate and enhance plant growth and kill pathogens.

On the 25th/07/2016, there was a report in the IFAD-VCDP Office from an Extension Officer in Iye-Uvir, Guma LGA that a Farmers organization farm was being infected by Rice weevils and needed urgent attention.

Due to the urgency required, it was decided that an effective insecticide be brought and used. This led to the demand of Path-away for trial.

On reaching the Farm with the product, the path-away/pathogen killer, it was applied on a 4M X4M portion of the Rice farm was sprayed with some quantity of the path-away/pathogen killer.

Outcome: within three to four days of the products application, it was observed that all the insects have disappeared from the 4M X 4M marked area of the Farm. The pale appearance of the leaves of the Rice seedlings have also disappeared.

PATH-AWAY APPLICATION REPORT

Path-Away Crop Protectant was supplied by C&C Burford Consulting Ltd. The samples were applied on Aondongu Saaku's farm in Gwer-West Local government Area of Benue State for control of pests.

The infected farm was spread with Path-Away Crop Protectant with Growth Enhancer. On the 5th day after the treatment, the farm was inspected again. It was observed that most of the pests were cleared off and crops spread had already started showing signs of rejuvenation.

Judging from the encouraging result of this limited trial we are hopeful that the product could prove immensely helpful in protecting our crops.
